Year/Semester Abroad

Stage/Work Placements in Italy

Dante International College in Vittorio Veneto, Italy, offers all under and post-graduate students in foreign universities, who wish to spend just one semester or their whole Erasmus/Leonardo year in Italy, the opportunity to compete for one of four work placements as Tutor/Language Assistant (English, German and Spanish) in its schools.

The small city of Vittorio Veneto is situated 90km from the well known ski resort of Cortina D'Ampezzo and 90km from Venice, with easy access to many beautiful cities such as Padua, Verona and Vicenza. Nearer still are the stylish cities of Treviso, home of the Benetton Rugby team, and Belluno, renowned for its ice rink and easy access to the Dolomites. Participants can therefore spend their free time skiing, walking or cycling in the breathtaking surrounding areas or visiting cities famous for their art and fashion. Additionally, there is the opportunity to **discover the artistic heritage of** the Palladian Villas of the Veneto, enjoy summer weekends at the nearby beaches of Jesolo, Lignano, Caorle and Venice Lido, and many other things which help to create a wonderful balance of work, cultural enrichment and free time.

The job (see below: work description and conditions) will enable you to gain first hand experience of teaching students (6-16 years old). At the end of your stay you will receive a certificate and a personal reference letter.

Work description and conditions:

Participants

will be accommodated in the Dante International College in self catered twin room with shared bathroom, kitchen and study/TV room. There is also a laundrette at the college;

will not receive an income, but will keep the total amount of your Erasmus/Leonardo grant and will have free accommodation, breakfast, lunch and dinner;

will be plenty of opportunities to practice Italian Language in their work and social life and under the supervision of a tutor helping them under all circumstances including oral and written Italian;

Monday to Friday (weekends are free), you will act as a language assistant in our foreign language classes (English, German and Spanish) for a maximum of 20/25 hours per week and supervise our very small cohort of boarding students (14-16 years old) for a maximum of two nights per week.

If you are an English language assistant, you may be teaching up to a maximum of 30 hours per week. In this case you will have no or maximum one night per week supervising boarding students, depending on the number of your teaching hours. Vice

versa, if you are a German or Spanish language assistant, you may teach for less than 20 hours per week and have a maximum of three nights per week supervising boarding students, depending on the number of your teaching hours.

You need to complete and send (to antonella.sonego@ildante.com) covering letter and CV providing: your name and surname, address, contact number, personal email, Skype address, any disabilities, home university, year of study, degree course, personal assessment of your level of Italian and any other foreign language you may speak, details about your education and any further detail you feel is appropriate.

There is no specific deadline to submit your application but, after 14th February, the places will be **assigned on a first come first serve basis**. It is therefore recommended that you send your application as soon as possible and ideally not after 14th February 2015. You will be contacted within 1 week to arrange an interview via Skype.

Should you be appointed, you must provide confirmation that you do not hold a criminal record before you arrive in Italy.
